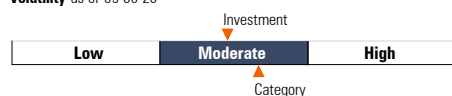
The investment seeks long-term capital growth and current income.

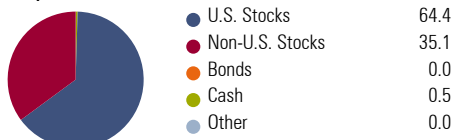
