The underlying funds invest in U.S. stocks, international stocks, U.S. bonds, and other debt instruments and the Portfolio uses an asset allocation strategy designed for investors expecting to retire around the year 2050.

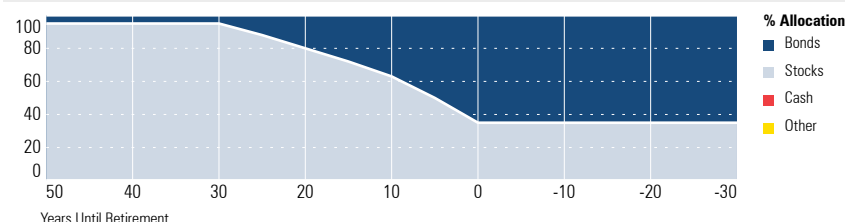

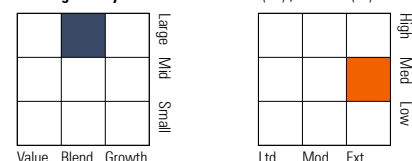

The Portfolio's Management Fee structure is a "bifurcated fee" structure as follows: an annual rate of 0.20% of the Portfolio's average daily net assets invested in Underlying Funds within the Voya family of funds, and 0.40% of the Portfolio's average daily net assets invested in direct investments. Total Annual Portfolio Operating Expenses may be higher than the Portfolio's ratio of expenses to average net assets shown in the Portfolio's Financial Highlights, which reflects the operating expenses of the Portfolio and does not include Acquired Fund Fees and Expenses. The adviser is contractually obligated to limit expenses to 0.86% for Class I shares through May 1, 2023. This limitation is subject to possible recoupment by the adviser within 36 months of the waiver or reimbursement. In addition, the adviser is contractually obligated to further limit expenses to 0.76% for Class I shares through May 1, 2023. The limitations do not extend to interest, taxes, investment-related costs, leverage expenses and extraordinary expenses. Termination or modification of these obligations requires approval by the Portfolio's board.
